

## **Calendar of Events for Córdoba Student Exchange**

### **January**

Individual student interviews are scheduled for applicants  
Family interviews are scheduled for applicants  
The January chapter meeting is a welcome to our incoming Argentine students and a welcome back to our Sheboygan County students\*  
Families receive food/raffle tickets to sell for the brat fry  
Outbound students apply for passports  
Inbound students arrive  
The exchange committee hosts a get-together for the returning Sheboygan students and their families and newly arrived Argentine students and their host families  
Inbound students register for classes

### **February**

Items are collected for the raffle at the brat fry  
Medical/Dental examinations are completed for outbound students

### **March**

Students' families volunteer at the annual brat fry (year of application, year of participation and year of return)

### **April**

Students are matched with their partners for the exchange as soon as information is available from Argentina  
Airline tickets are purchased for outbound students (family does this)

### **May**

People to People Annual Meeting  
US students who have recently returned and Argentine students plan a brief powerpoint program - 15-20 minutes in length\*  
Outbound students receive scholarships at this meeting\*

### **June**

Meet with program coordinator for a student orientation  
Finalize all student forms; notarize parental permission

### **July**

Outbound students leave for Argentina  
Argentine students depart  
PTP annual picnic

### **October**

Presentations are made at local schools to recruit students

## **November**

Applications are available for students who are interested in participating in the exchange during the following year

## **December**

Argentina applications are due for the following year's program  
Argentina applications are reviewed by the committee members  
The December chapter meeting is a holiday celebration and farewell to the inbound German students\*
